

**SR-71 Blackbird** The SR-71 served reconnaissance with the U.S. Air Force from 1964 to 1998. Since 1976, it has held the world record for the fastest air-breathing manned aircraft. A total of 32 were built; 12 were lost in accidents, but none lost to enemy action. March Field Air Museum's SR-71 dates from 1967 and flew 82 sorties during the Vietnam War (and numerous other missions throughout the world).
